






















How to help your child get it right at Stalham High!


The key part of the LSU – Support!

Teaching and Learning in Year 7

- Mixed ability groups (7S, 7T, 7A, 7L + 7H for some subjects)
- Assessment:
 - Students are assessed at least once per term
 - We report percentages (and class/cohort average)
 - These do not relate to GCSE grades by design!
